### **General Information**

The Virginia National Guard (VANG), in cooperation with the Virginia Department of Emergency Management (VDEM) and the Virginia Department of Health (VDH), is providing the COVID-19 Vaccine at the National Guard Armory in Blackstone, VA from Monday – Thursday.

## FAQs

### 1. Is there a charge for the vaccine? Will I need proof of insurance?

There is no charge for the COVID-19 vaccine and no insurance documents are required.

### 2. Which Vaccine is being provided?

Moderna Vaccine is being provided at this location.

### 3. If I have already received one dose of vaccine before, can I get my second dose of vaccine at this site?

Yes, but only if your first dose was Moderna vaccine. Also, the vaccine doses must be given at least 28 days apart.

### 4. If I receive a first dose at the CVC site, how will my second dose be scheduled?

About 7 to 10 days after your first dose appointment you should receive a text or email with instructions for scheduling your second dose appointment. You can also call 877-VAX-IN-VA (877-829-4682) to schedule your second dose appointment.

### 5. Can people under the age of 18 receive their vaccine at the Nottoway CVC site?

No. The vaccine being offered at the Nottoway CVC site is the Moderna vaccine, which is only approved for people 18 years of age and older. The Pfizer vaccine is approved for people 16 years of age and older. ### 6. Are there any contraindications that I should know about that could prevent me from being vaccinated at the Nottoway CVC site?

Yes. If you have a history of severe allergies that require you to carry epinephrine, or you have had severe allergic reactions to other vaccines, we ask that you not come to the CVC site for your vaccine – it is recommended that you receive your vaccine at a doctor's office that can provide treatment should you have an allergic reaction. The Nottoway CVC team has the ability to provide emergency response if needed, but it would be safer to receive the vaccine at a medical practice.
